This conference is open to individuals who carry out or are interested in qualitative research in the area of applied linguistics. During this conference, we hope to address and open up the discussion of a number of issues related to applied linguistics such as: bilingual, heritage and minority education; culture; discourse analysis; educational linguistics; identity; ideology; language maintenance; language teaching; language planning; language and power; research methodology; second language acquisition; sociolinguistics; or socialization, to name a few.

The call for presentations is now open until **March 8, 2023**, and results will be provided by **March 15, 2023**. We welcome two types of presentations: academic sessions: in-progress or finished research (30 minutes: 20 minutes of presentation and 10 minutes of discussion, 1-3 participants) and academic discussion groups (60 minutes: 45 minutes of presentation and 15 minutes of questions, 2-4 participants). Presentations can be given in English or Spanish but be aware that **interpretation services will not be provided**.

Information needed for your proposal is: names of the presenters; affiliation; email address for each participant; title of presentation (no more than 20 words); type of presentation: academic presentation: finished or in-progress or academic discussion group; abstract (150-200 words); and biodata of each presenter (50 words each).
